- 1-1:30pm Water Play

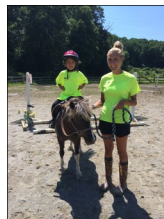


We use ponies of all sizes to teach students how to ride. Each child has a private riding lesson every day. The week ends in a horse show.

## Reasons why SVF Camp is Exceptional

- We hire only counselors who exhibit a true passion for horses and teaching children. They engage with the kids to provide a memorable experience.
- Low counselor to child ratios. Riding is 1:1. Activities 1:5. Low ratios = individual attention
- Unlike other camps who teach with group lessons, each child has a daily 30 minute PRIVATE riding lesson to maximize learning and safety.
- Well planned weekly themes add extra fun and adventure to riding horses.
- Campers participate in team based games to reinforce their learning of horsemanship concepts.
- The art projects are unique and challenging.
- The ponies and horses are safe, well trained and accustomed to children. Most are owned by SVF.
- Campers learn a dance routine to a pop song and they perform it during the horse show. This helps them to learn rhythm, a necessary skill for riding.
- Every week ends with an art show and horse show so the children can display what they've accomplished during their stay with us.
- Before /Aftercare includes planned activities. Riding lessons optional.
